



CHOOSING THE RIGHT MAT



Floortex mats are versatile and allow flooring surfaces to shine through. In order to maximise the lifespan of your mat, whatever you use it for, match it to the surface it protects.

Use this simple guide to ensure your mat provides years of use and continues to maintain the pristine appearance of your flooring.

1 CHECK YOUR SURFACE

CARPETS



Spiked gripper backing will keep the mat in place without damaging the carpet. You'll need to make sure that your mat is thick enough for the pile of your carpet.



To determine the pile of your carpet take a straightened paperclip and sink it into the carpet, through the backing until it reaches the floor.



Grab the paper clip with your thumb and index finger at the point where it is flush with the carpet. Measure the distance between your fingers and the end of the paperclip to work out the carpet's thickness.

HARD FLOOR



Our standard smooth backed mats will protect your hard floors whether they are wooden, laminate, tiles or concrete without marks or damage. Our anti-slip mats feature a very low tack coating which is perfect for polished surfaces and will also leave no marks.



MATS ARE MADE FOR THESE SURFACES...



Low Pile Carpet - less than 6mm thick



Standard Pile Carpet - less than 9mm thick



Medium Pile Carpet - less than 12mm thick



Deep Pile Carpet - over 12mm thick



Hard Floors - Natural wood, laminate, tiles, concrete and vinyl.

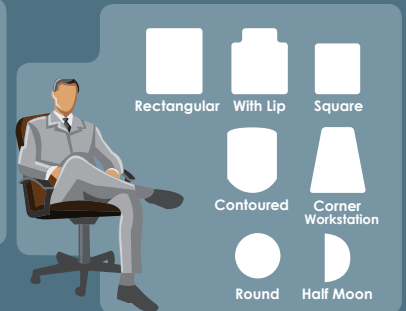


2 CHOOSE THE RIGHT SHAPE

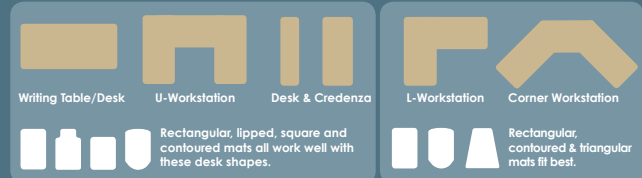
There's a wide range of shapes to suit any space, from the basic to the aesthetic.
